- 1.1 The scope of the MoU will be to collaborate for research and teaching in the designated subjects of Chemical Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Life Science and Physical Sciences, or any other field / discipline of mutual interest
- 1.2 NSCBM Government College Hamirpur and faculty members of the concerned departments of Career Point University will work towards joint research

projects.

- 1.3 NSCBM Government College Hamirpur will recognize and accredit Career Point University scientists for guiding research leading to Ph.D. degrees.
- 1.4 In case of any academic lapses, Career Point University will bring the matter to the notice of Principal NSCBM Government College Hamirpur and vice versa NSCBM Government College Hamirpur will bring the matter to the notice of the Vice Chancellor, Career Point University for initiating necessary action.
- 1.5 The faculty and students of the concerned departments of Career Point University shall be enrolled as ad-hoc members of the library of the NSCBM Government College Hamirpur. While using NSCBM Government College Hamirpur library facilities they shall be governed by the rules and regulations as operative in NSCBM Government College Hamirpur. Faculty members and students of NSCBM Government College Hamirpur shall likewise be given ad-hoc membership of the Career Point University library.
- 1.6 The faculty and students of the concerned departments of Career Point University shall be issued temporary identity cards by NSCBM Government College Hamirpur as per CSIR rules/ guidelines, so as to provide them an unhindered access to lab and other facilities of the Institute. Similarly, faculty and students of the NSCBM Government College Hamirpur shall be issued temporary identity cards by Career Point University as per rules/ guidelines to provide unhindered access to their lab and other facilities.
- 1.7 The aforesaid faculty and students of respective organization shall be provided with Photostat facilities on the same terms and conditions as are provided to their staff and research fellows.
- 1.8 As per the availability, NSCBM Government College Hamirpur/Career Point University shall arrange Hostel/Guest House accommodation for students/faculty coming to respective institute for training/teaching as per extant guidelines of respective Institutes.
- 1.9 In all cases related to work under this MoU T.A./ D.A. for faculty and research scholars will be borne by the respective organizations.

2. Academic Programs:

- 2.1 For the mutual benefit of the two Institutions i.e. NSCBM Government College Hamirpur and Career Point University, there will be exchange of NSCBM Government College Hamirpur faculty members of the concerned departments of Career Point University.
- 2.2 While registering NSCBM Government College Hamirpur staff/Student for Ph.D. degree the ordinances related to Ph.D. of Career Point University will be valid including the appointment of supervisors and co-supervisors.
- 2.3 NSCBM Government College Hamirpur and Career Point University will work closely to generate appropriately trained manpower in the areas of Ph.D. etc.

2.4 NSCBM Government College Hamirpur /Career Point University faculty will assist in the evaluation of student's performance of respective institutes in theory as well as practical classes.

3. Arbitration: Except as herein before provided, any dispute arising out of this MoU, the same shall be referred to Delhi International Arbitration Centre (DIAC), Delhi High Court, New Delhi and the decision of such (DIAC), as the case may be, shall be final and binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi and the arbitration proceedings shall take place under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996

It is agreed that the progress of this MoU shall be monitored by the Review Committee comprising of Vice-Chancellor, Career Point University and Director, Principal NSCBM Government College Hamirpur through periodic meetings.

This MoU is valid for a period of 5 (five) years starting 05.03.2022 subject to further extension on mutually agreed upon terms and conditions Any mid-term change/alteration in the terms and conditions of MoU as suggested by the Review Committee shall also be deemed to be valid for both the Institutions. The MoU may be terminated if any of the parties wants to withdraw from it. However, the Ph.D. students admitted under the MoU shall be governed by the same terms and conditions as prevailing at the time of signing of this MoU, till the completion of their degrees under the ordinances of Career Point University.
