Kanika Kaondal

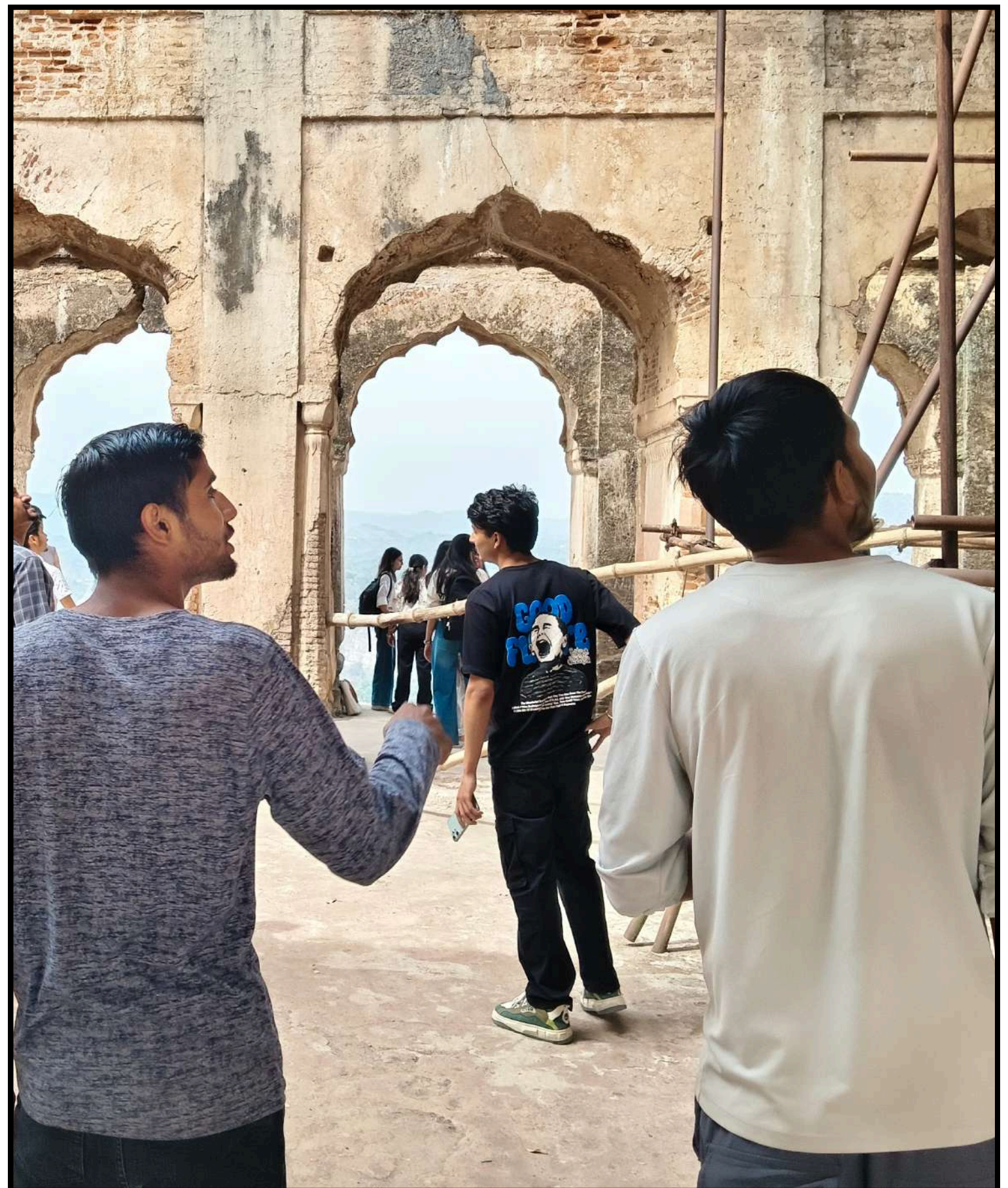
A total of more than 35 students participated in the trip along with the faculty members. The journey was undertaken in the bus named “Rangra Bus.”



Places Visited

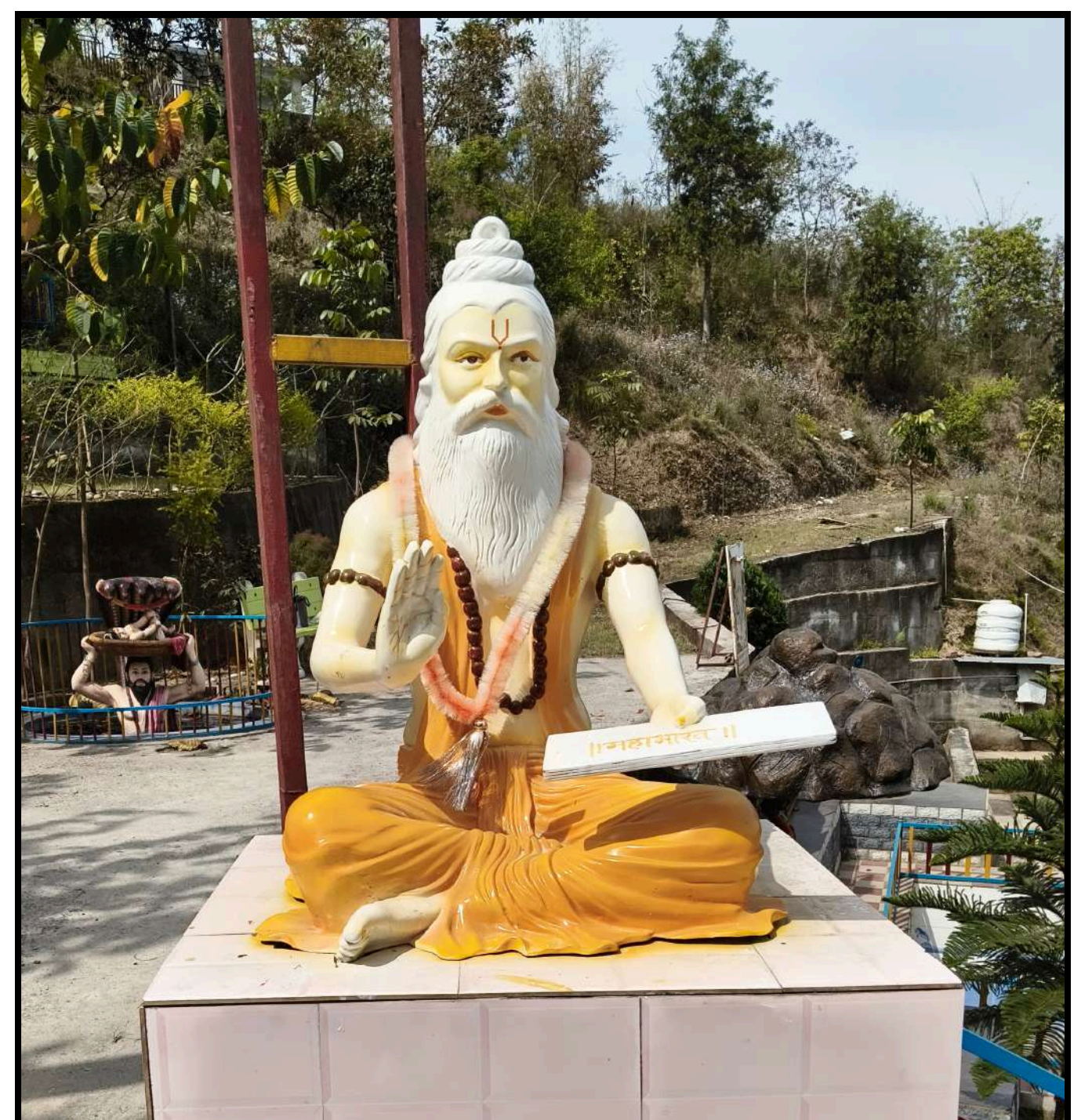
1. Sujanpur Fort

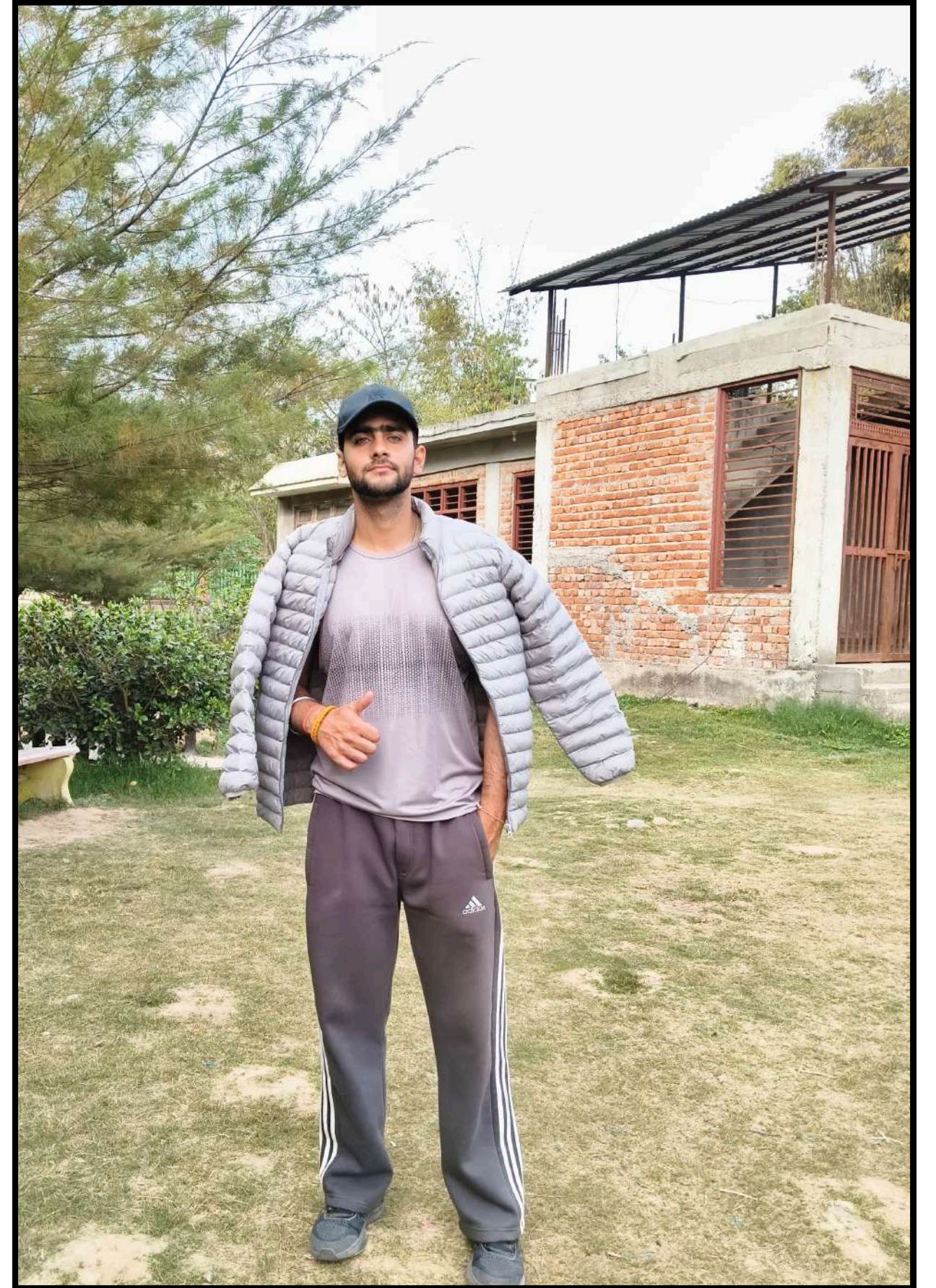
3. Sujanpur Holi Fair
