Report on Mentor Mentee Activities (Session 2024-25)

The Student mentoring system is introduced in the Department of Economics. Teachers are involved in the process of mentoring. Every mentor prepares a list of all the students allotted to him / her with details of Name, Class, Division, Roll Number, Contact Number and E Mail Id. The mentor has a chalked-out responsibilities to take care of all the mentees such as to provide them career counseling, to provide them personal counseling, to support them for any kind of difficulty in their curriculum, to make provision of remedial coaching for them and to always support them as and when required.

The mentor also works for finding out hidden talent of the students in various aspects of academic, co – curricular and extra – curricular activities so that they can be promoted to do various activities in the concerned area for their holistic development. The mentor also contacts and meets the parents of his / her mentees to discuss their progress and / or any other matter, as and when required.

- Contemporary Economic status.(Regional, National and Global)
- Area of Interest.
- Public conversation/ presentation
- Personal, familial, social and academic issues.

Frequency of meeting

The mentor mentee ratio is 1:30 which greatly helps the mentor to focus on all the issues raised by the students. The mentor meets the students twice in a month and whenever required to discuss about the academics & other beneficiary topics.
