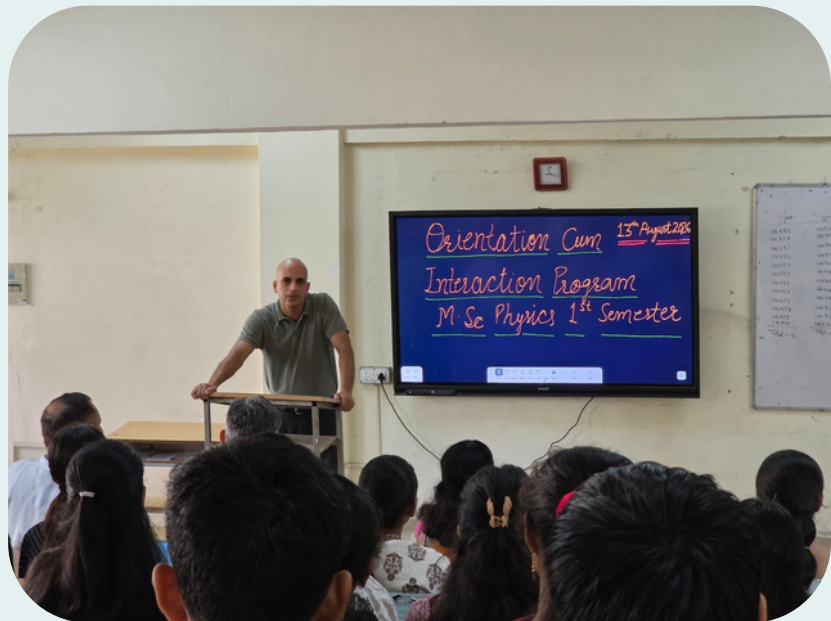
"Welcome juniors! Here's to long lab hours, endless derivations, and finally figuring out that when life gets chaotic, non-linear dynamics was just preparing you for it."

Connecting Beyond the Classroom



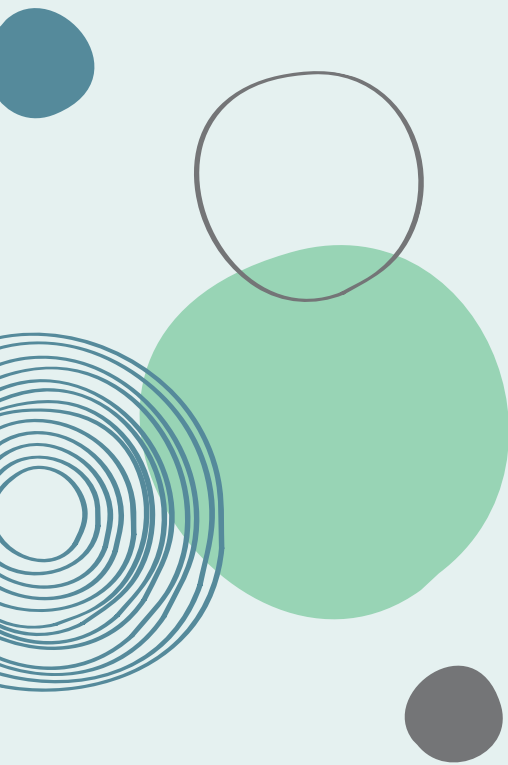
