About the College

NSCBM Govt. College Hamirpur has entered into the 6th decade of its glorious journey after its inception in 1965. In the last 5 decades college and striving to be an institution of excellence. This institution has progressively emerged as one of the leading institution of higher learning in Himachal Pradesh with its sole motto of transformation of the students into awakened, responsible and accountable citizen. The college started with the name of Govt. College, Hamirpur and then in 1995 Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose has been prefixed to the name of this college. The college is located in the hilly terrain of district Head quarter of Hamirpur. It is covered by 2(f) and 12(B) by the UGC. The last year, it was re-accredited with 'B' Grade with 2.83 points by NAAC.

The college offers different undergraduate programmes in Humanities, Science (Med. & Non Med., Computer Science) and Commerce and post Graduate courses in English Hindi, Commerce and Economics. The college also runs self-financing courses in BBA BCA and PGDCA and Add-on-courses in Tourism & Travel Management, Journalism and Computer Application. The highly qualified faculty of the college is imparting value based quality education in various fields.

The campus of the college is spread over nearly 22 acres of land with a standard playground for all major outdoor games. The college provides facilities for indoor games along with a gymnasium for exercise. The college has well equipped labs for different science streams including computer labs with internet facilities. Different departments are connected with VPN Broadband & Lease Line facilities. The new college library is also connected through Library Management Software 'SOUL' developed by INFLIBNET. The new stadium of the college with 400mtr synthetic track is also available in the college. The construction of the modern indoor stadium, with budgetary provision of Rs.572.01 lacs, is in progress. The seven residential quarter (Type -IV) and Four (Type-II) has been newly constructed There are separate hostels for boys and girls with each having capacity of 100 students.

Different activities in the college such as sports, cultural, NSS, NCC, Rovers & Rangers and Rotract are instrumental in channelizing and translating the strengths of the students. Over the year the college has acquired an excellent reputation by exhibiting outstanding performance in academics, sports, cultural and co-curricular activities. The college has its own website www.gchamirpur.org for providing various details of the college activities.

ADMISSION PROCESS:

The college is running two undergraduate programmes BBA/BCA and one post graduate diploma programme PGDCA in self-Financing Mode. The admission procedure for all the courses is given here under:

BBA COURSE:

There is a total of 100 (Hundred) seats in BBA Programme out of which **60 (sixty)** seats are under subsidized Category and 40 (forty) seats are under Non-subsidized Category.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO BBA PROGRAMME:

Minimum Eligibility for admission to BBA Programme is Plus Two examination under 10+2 system or examination equivalent thereto of a Board/ University established by Law in India with 45% marks (40% marks for Scheduled Caste/ Schedule Tribes)

OR

Any examination of a University/ Board/ College or School in foreign country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/ equivalence committee of its own or on recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with **45% marks (40% marks in case of SC/ST)**.

AGE LIMIT (BBA):

The maximum age limit for the course is **22 years** on the 1st July of the year concerned, provided that in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes, the upper age limit will be **relaxed by three years**. Provided further that the Vice-Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation for reasons to be recorded in writing up to a **maximum of six months**.

BASIS OF ADMISSION TO BBA

There shall be an admission test for candidates seeking admission to BBA Course. Admission to BBA comprises of three stages i.e., Application Rating, Written Test (consisting of General English, General Mathematics, General Knowledge and General Management) & Interview. The entrance test of one and half hour duration shall consist of one paper of 70 marks (70 questions of 1 mark each).

1. Application Ratings: 30 Marks (10% of marks percentage of marks obtained in matriculation exam and 20% of marks percentage obtained in 10+2 examinations). While computing merit a candidate having commerce or Mathematics as a subject at 10+2 Level will be given additional weightage of 10 marks).

Note: The Entrance Test is also used for the screening the candidates for the Group Discussion and Interview. **No re-evaluation or rechecking of marks is allowed for written test.**

Composition of BBA Entrance Test:

The BBA Entrance Test will comprise of four parts:

Note: There will be no reservations of any kind in allowed in Non-Subsidized category. Further, Separate Merit List shall be prepared for subsidized category and Non-Subsidized category

BCA COURSE:

There is a total of 100 (Hundred) seats in BCA Programme out of which **60 (sixty)** seats are under subsidized Category and 40 (forty) seats are under Non-subsidized Category.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO BCA:

Minimum Eligibility for admission to BCA Programme is plus two examination under 10+2 system or examination equivalent thereto of a Board/ University established by Law in India with **40% marks (35% marks for Scheduled Caste/ Schedule Tribes)**

OR

Any examination of a University/ Board/ College or School in foreign country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/ equivalence committee of its own or on recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with **40% marks (35% marks in case of SC/ST)**.

AGE LIMIT (BCA):

The maximum age limit for the course is **21 years** for male candidates of General Category, **23 years** for female candidates of General category and **24 years** for both male and female Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe category as on the 1st July of the year concerned. The Vice-Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to **maximum of six months**.

BASIS OF ADMISSION (BCA)

The final admission to BCA is based on the merit of BCA Entrance Test.

PGDCA COURSE:

There is a total of 60 (Sixty) seats in PGDCA Programme out of which **30 (Thirty)** seats are under subsidized Category and 30 (Thirty) seats are under Non-subsidized Category.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PGDCA:

Minimum Eligibility for admission to PGDCA Programme is Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with a minimum of 48 credits in Major subject, 48 credits in two minor subjects, 09 credits in compulsory, 01 credit GI & hobby with aggregate of 106 credits for the award of pass degree

OR

A Bachelor's (Hons.) Degree in any discipline with a minimum of 56 credits in Major subject, 40 credits In two minor subject, 09 credits in compulsory, 01 credit GI & hobby and 14 credits in additional/compulsory/ skill-based and 03 credit in GI & hobby) with aggregate of 120 credits for the award of Honours degree.

OR

At least 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC/ST from a University established by Law in India).

OR

Any examination of a University/ Board/ College or School in foreign country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/ equivalence committee of its own or on

recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with **40% marks (35% marks in case of SC/ST)**.

AGE LIMIT (PGDCA):

The maximum age limit for the candidate seeking admission to PGDCA programme shall be 26 years for male candidates, 28 years for female candidates and 29 years for SC/ST candidates as on 1st July of the admission year.

BASIS OF ADMISSION (PGDCA)

Admission to the course will be made strictly on the basis of marks obtained in the Bachelor's degree.

Note: There will be no reservations of any kind in allowed in Non-Subsidized category. Further, Separate Merit List shall be prepared for subsidized category and Non-Subsidized category

The roster of admission (120-point roster), showing reservations of various categories shall be used as per H.P. University rules.

The number of seats for subsidized and non-subsidized categories will be as under:

PROCEDURE OF SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

1. Log on to website www.gchamirpur.org and download the prospectus and read it carefully to understand the eligibility criteria and other requirements for submission of online application. Read the instructions and procedure for online submission of application form carefully.
2. Before proceeding to apply, the candidates are required to go through the User Manual of admission available on www.gchamirpur.org .

Note: 1. The candidate must fill all details in online form carefully, as the admission process for students will be based on the provided information.

2. Before proceeding further please make sure that the fields are filled correctly in the confirmation screen before clicking the submit button.

3. Before proceeding to apply, please ensure that you have:

I. Scanned copy of candidate's recent photograph with following specifications
Photograph must be passport size colour picture.

- Photograph must be taken in full face view directly facing the camera.
- Photograph should have no shadows and red eyes. Photograph should have maximum size of 200 kb.
- Photo form should be .jpg, .jpeg, .bmp, .png.

II. Scanned copy of candidate's signature with following specifications. Applicant should sign with black ink on a white paper and get the signature scanned.

- The signature must be signed only by the candidate and not by any other person. This signature has to be verified by the invigilator at the time of examination and at the time of Counseling/admission by the committee.
- Signature should have maximum size of 200 kb.
- Scanned signature format should be .jpg,.jpeg,.bmp,.png only.

III. Scanned copy of 10th Marksheet in any of the format .jpg,.jpeg,.bmp,.png,.pdf and file size should be less than 200KB.

IV. Scanned copy of Himachal Bonafide (if applicable) in any of the format .jpg, .jpeg, bmp, .png, .pdf and file size should be less than 200KB.

V. Create an email account if you already don't have one. It is mandatory as it will be used as your User ID/Login ID.

VI. You must give a mobile number for Registration. If you don't have mobile number, enter your parent/guardian's working mobile number for any further correspondence/ communication in this regard.

VII. All the fields marked with red star are mandatory to be filled up by the candidate.

5. Before submitting the final information on each web page, the candidate must ensure that the information filled by him/her are correct. Once candidate “click on the final submission button” of his/her application page, he/she cannot edit/change the details entered.

After successful remittance of fee, system will generate for final submission to print the confirmation page of the online application form and then a message will be sent on registered mobile number. Follow the instructions to take the print out of confirmation page of online application form. **Please keep the confirmation page and proof of payment of fee safely for any future references.**
7. Failure to complete any of the step of online Application Form and payment of fee as per requirement of online process, final submission of online application will remain incomplete and unsuccessful all modes of payment of fee.
8. Generation of confirmation page confirms the correctness and final submission of application form. If confirmation page has not been generated, this means that application has not submitted successfully.
9. The Last date for submission of ONLINE Application form with successful final transaction of fee is **10.06.2026 till 5:00pm** after which the link will be disabled.



Important Directions for the Candidates
