Hostel Overview:

The college allocates hostel accommodation to Undergraduate and Postgraduate students from all streams.

The following observations were made by the committee members under the following categories:

Mess Services

Commendable mess services were observed, providing nutritious meals that meet the required standards for a healthy and balanced diet. Hygiene protocols in food preparation were diligently followed. The mess caters to the dietary needs of the students.

Infrastructure and Room Amenities:

The hostel's infrastructure, including rooms, was found to be up to the mark. Rooms are well-equipped with beds, racks, tables, and chairs, ensuring a comfortable stay for all residents.

Cleanliness Standards:

The cleanliness of the hostel premises, including common areas, corridors, rooms, and washrooms, met the expected standards. Regular cleaning and maintenance routines were evident, contributing to a hygienic environment.

Student Involvement:

Students collectively approve the menu, ensuring their preferences are considered. Standard brands of eatables are used for cooking in the mess, emphasizing hygienic food practices.

Staff and Discipline:

A dedicated staff, including the Resident Warden, Office Clerk, Hostel Attendant/Night Chowkidar, and Sweeper, caters to the needs of the residents. Strict rules are in place to maintain discipline and hygiene within the hostel premises.

Additional Facilities and Initiatives:

The hostel organizes Anti-Ragging, Anti-Drugs, and Yoga classes, emphasizing a holistic approach to student well-being. Sports and recreational facilities are also provided.

Areas for Improvement:





Several areas require attention to enhance the residents' experience:

- White washing of the hostel building.
- Replacement of damaged electrical switches.
- Replacement of water supply pipes and taps.
- Implementation of regular pest control and fumigation/spray for protection from rats and mosquitoes.

The committee conducted a food quality check, confirming that it meets the expected standards.


Recommendations:


1. Regular Maintenance Checks: Implement regular maintenance checks for all facilities to ensure longevity and functionality.





Recommendations for Student Satisfaction:
